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Student Stop-Out and Readmission Policy

Purpose: The purpose of this policy is to identify the number of consecutive terms a student may not be enrolled in classes at Creighton University before being required to submit an application for readmission.

Policy:

Students previously enrolled at Creighton University who have not been enrolled at Creighton University for at least four consecutive semesters or eight consecutive 7/8 week terms (excluding summer) must submit an application for readmission prior to re-enrolling at the University.

All financial and enrollment obligations to the University must be cleared prior to re-enrollment.

Scope: This policy applies to all students entering Creighton University through the College of Professional Studies.

Administration and Interpretation: This policy is administered by the College of Professional Studies. Questions regarding this policy should be referred to the College of Professional Studies.
